Eligibility -

- Students with >= 75% marks in Class IX/ Pre-board Result of Class X are eligible for direct the admission. Minimum eligibility can be relaxed for students who have extra achievements in co-curricular areas.
- Students with < 75% marks in Class IX/ Pre-board Result of Class X will be required to give an admission test. The admission test will consist of basic level questions from Arithmetic, English, General Science and General knowledge (conducted after board examinations)

Admission process-

- 1. Registration Kindly collect the registration form and prospectus from school reception and submit duly filled form along with the necessary documents (view documents at bottom of this document)
- 2. Entrance Test / Interview Students who clear the eligibility criteria mentioned abovewill be required to take an interview (along with parents). The interview will be conducted by the coordinator (Senior Secondary Wing)
- 3. Results Admission results will be communicated within 1-2 days of the interview. Parents will be required to submit admission fee within 2 working days or else admission will be forfeited.

Points to be noted -

Admission will be CONFIRMED after the student submits the original mark sheets, character certificate and the Transfer certificate on or before 15th July. The classes will start from mid-April 2024
